1. Required training content

“Egypt Enneagram Practitioner” qualification with at least 84 hours in 12 days

- **The 27 Enneagram SubTypes**
Each 9 types has 3 SubTypes (Self-Preservation, Social, One to one) They come give another layer of complexity to the Enneatypes. It is important to know them as they are easy to change and would be an important first step to understand how to move around in the Enneagram symbol.
- **The Three Brains behind the 9 Types & The Three main Instincts**
This explains how the Subtypes came to be through the emotional centers. This includes: The Instinctual Sequence (Stack), The Dominant Instinct, The Repressed (Blind) Instinct.
- **The Enneagram Harmonic Groups**
The enneagram is broken into groups of three. The most popular group is the Center of Intelligence. There are many of these groupings and all are worth understanding. One such grouping is referred to as the Harmonic Groups.
Enneagram Harmonic Groups helps show how each type copes with conflict and difficulties. Harmonic groups also show how we defend against disappointment.
The three Enneagram Harmonic Groups are broken down in to the Positive Outlook Group, the Competency Group, and the Reactive Group.
- **The Harmony Groups**
Enneagram Harmony Groups shows us how each of three groups relate to the world. The Harmony Groups are broken down into: the Idealist Group, the Pragmatist group, & the Relationist Group.
- **Hornevian Groups**
Enneagram Hornevian Groups help show us how each enneagram type interacts with other people to meet their own needs. The three Enneagram Hornevian Groups are broken down into the Compliant Group, the Withdrawn Group, and the Assertive Group.
- **The Levels Of Development (How Each Type will Look Like in each Stage/Level of Awareness)**



9 Stage of awareness on how Healthy or Unhealthy each types behave on a gradient explain what behaviour they would adopt at each stage.

The Process Enneagram

The view of Enneagram by George Gurdjieff. Before the more popular Enneagram of Personality, George Gurdjieff had his own vision of Enneagram that takes in a higher globality of the processes of each thing as a systemic.

- The Law of One / Octave
- The Law of Three
- The Law of Seven

The Law of Seven or law of octaves, according to which phenomena evolves in seven steps; and the Law of Three, according to which phenomena are produced by three forces, are presented by Gurdjieff as global laws appearing on all scales and essential to his cosmology.

- **Fixation of the types during childhood**

Explaining on how each types appears in the childhood, why and when will it manifest. Some types have the tendency to appear earlier than other. It is not possible to have a voluntary impact in fixation of the type, as it will depend only of the child's understand and own view of the world and his emotions.

Understanding of the child's development and behavior according to typology Learning what would make children even more blooming in what they do, to make sure they are happy, learn the way that is best intended in a tailor-made manner to them and grow being aware of their capacities while expending them to new horizons.

- **Assessments & Typing Interview (To recognise in others their Enneatype)**

Knowing what question to ask, what to look for to find your own type and others. The way someone behaves, look like, speaks, would react to a given situation, what is important to them etc...

Written and Behavioral assessments are highly recommended

The written assessment tests the integration of the required "Enneagram Expert, EWA" training contents and ensures high-quality learning.

The behavioral assessment should be tailored to the relevant experiences of the participants. The behavioral assessment enables the participants to demonstrate their behavioral integration of the selected Enneagram training content.

Details of the contents and form of the written and behavioral assessment are chosen by the responsible "Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA".



2. Binding formal training organization

Training duration for “Egypt Enneagram Practitioner”

- Minimum of 84 hours of on-site face-to-face or interactive online training (including assessment) over a period of at least 12 days

Mandatory Details

- **The title “Egypt Enneagram Practitioner”** can only be used on a certificate with an EWA seal.
- **A training hour** has 60 minutes. Breaks longer than 30 minutes are not counted as training time.
- **A training group** has at least 6 members (counted without assistants or “Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA”).
- **EWA sealed certificates** (sticker with the EWA logo and a unique seal number) are for EWA trainings that have been conducted at least 80% of the time by an approved “Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA”. The remaining up to 20% of the training can be conducted by another highly qualified person under the supervision of an “Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA”. The training content in this curriculum here needs to be covered.
- **Optional interactive online Training:** All “Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA” may use **online interactive** training (e.g., Zoom with breakout groups) as long as they specifically write the number of days and hours that were online in the text of the certificate.
- **Optional online non-interactive training hours** (asynchronous training), up to 20% of course hours, are only allowed for Master Trainers who have received a written approval from our online commission. To submit your request for approval, please write to office@in-ici.net

Optional Details

- With more than 10 participants, it is highly recommended to involve an assistant who must be qualified at least at the level: “**Egypt Enneagram Practitioner**”.
- We recommend individual or group supervision, buddies, peer coaching, and intervention.

“Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA” can order seals in their login area.

The options are:

- our wonderful designed online certificate (you find for this a video in your login area)
- jpg or png seals that you can print on your own certificates
- physical seals (the old and most inconvenient time-consuming way by snail mail)



3. Guidelines for certificates

The EWA certificate for: “Egypt Enneagram Practitioner” must include:

1. **the correct title** of the qualification: “Egypt Enneagram Practitioner”
2. **Duration, Entrance Qualification, optional Online Training,**
The **duration** of the face-to-face training with precise information regarding training days and hours (at least 84 hours in 12 days) plus the required **entrance qualification**
If interactive online training was used, the precise amount of hours and days of the interactive online training part must be stated on the certificate.
If non-interactive online training was used, the “Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA” needs a written allowance from the online commission for this, and the precise amount of hours and days of the interactive online training part must be stated on the certificate. 3. **the date** of the first and last day of the training
4. **a statement** that all EWA guidelines have been met
We recommend for 2. to 4. the following 2 sentences on the certificate:
The training comprised of 84 full hours in 12 days on-site face-to-face training, from ...(date of first day) to ...(date of last day), in strict accordance with the high ethics and quality standards of the Enneagram World Association (EWA).
The entrance qualification was “**Egypt Enneagram Basics, EWA**”.
If a mixture of on-site face-to-face training and interactive online training was used, we recommend the following 2 sentences on the certificate:
The training comprised of ... full hours in ... days on-site face-to-face training and ... full hours in ... days interactive face-to-face online training, from ...(date of first day) to ...(date of last day), in strict accordance with the high ethics and quality standards of the Enneagram World Association (EWA).
The entrance qualification was “**Egypt Enneagram Basics**”.
5. **the EWA seal** (sticker with EWA logo and seal number)
6. **the signature** of the "Enneagram Master Trainer, EWA" (with place and date)

Training content for the qualification: We highly recommend to list the complete trained main content and the complete amount of training hours and days that are needed for the certified qualification in Enneagram on the backside of the certificate or on a separate signed document.

The following statement is optional for an EWA sealed certificate:

"Because of the high quality of this training it may be recognized as ECTS credit points in academic studies in psychology with a focus on Enneagram."
